Core values of The Gideons International in South Africa

1. An uncompromised belief that the Bible is the inspired, infallible, and inerrant Word of God.
2. An intentional focus on the objective of winning others to the Lord Jesus Christ, through:
 - a. The association of Christian business and professional men for service
 - b. Personal testimony and personal work by individual Gideons
 - c. Placing the Bible - God's Holy Word and portions thereof, in hotels, hospitals, schools, institutions, and also through distribution of Scriptures for an individual's personal use.
3. A membership consisting of business and professional men who:
 - a. Are not practising Clergymen, Pastors, Ministers of a Church, Evangelist or missionaries
 - b. Believe in the Bible as the inspired (i.e., infallible and inerrant) Word of God
 - c. Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the eternal Son of God
 - d. Have received Him as their personal Saviour
 - e. Endeavour to follow Him in their daily lives
 - f. Believe in the endless lake of fire for the unsaved
 - g. Accept the biblical standard of marriage being between one biological man and one biological woman
 - h. Are members in good standing of an evangelic or Protestant church, congregation, or assembly
 - i. Participate in the activities of a camp.

4. An integral part of the Association known as the Gideons' Wives, is comprised of the member wives of Gideons who meet the same spiritual qualifications. The purpose of the Gideons' Wives is to assist the Gideons in their single objective (to win others for the Lord Jesus Christ) through prayer, personal testimony, personal work, association for service, and placing and distributing the Bible—God's Holy Word—or portions thereof in approved venues.
5. An ongoing emphasis on the importance of fulfilling the Seven Spiritual Objectives:
 - Men and women of the **Word**.
 - Men and women of **faith**.
 - Men and women of **prayer**.
 - Men and women of **separated walk**.
 - Men and women of **compassionate heart**.
 - Men and women who **witness**.
 - Men and women who **give**.
6. Funding for the mission of the Association is secured through personal contributions and bequests, contributions by churches, and through *Friends of Gideons*.
7. Recognition of an intentional relationship with Evangelical and Protestant churches as a prayer base, a source of members, and financial support.
8. A simple, disciplined, well-defined ministry which is carried out exclusively by the membership of The Association under the authority and direction of the International Cabinet.
